# Ex-ante publicity notice in negotiated procurement procedure

Subject: "ECDC Official Car" NP/2016/DIR/5651/01

### **Short description**

The objective of this tender is to purchase a new official (diplomatic) car to ECDC.

## **Minimum requirements**

#### 1. General:

1. Mid-sized executive class car with saloon/sedan body/4 doors

### 2. Safety features:

- 1. All-wheel drive (AWD) or comparable system
- 2. Automatic transmission gearbox
- 3. Side impact head protection curtains in both front and back seats
- 4. Fog lights in both front and rear
- 5. Remote controlled central locking system with burglar alarm
- 6. Additional powerful revers lights integrated or placed underneath the rear bumper
- 7. Both summer tires and winter tires (not studded)
- 8. Laminated windows

## 3. Other

- 1. Fully integrated updateable GPS navigation system with traffic information system or comparable
- 2. Drive computer or a comparable vehicle information system
- 3. Leather upholstery
- 4. Sun curtains on the rear door windows and the rear window
- 5. Metallic paint
- 6. Display language in all vehicle system: English
- 7. Sound system with Bluetooth system
- 8. First aid kit
- 9. Fire-extinguishers

ECDC expects the candidate to take over the current vehicle at the time of the delivery of the new vehicle.

### **Description of the procedure:**

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of a negotiated procurement procedure below 60,000 with a minimum of 3 candidates, through which ECDC may award the above-mentioned contract.

All economic operators interested in providing the services described above should express their interest before **26/10/2016**, 16h00 CET, by e-mail to **tenders@ecdc.europa.eu** with the same subject reference as indicated above.

In their expression of interest interested economic operators should demonstrate their ability to provide the relevant services and provide the following information:
